Tucked back on the corner, Cheffins sits between its original village roots and the main westerly coast road. Revived to its former glory, you cant miss Cheffins at Beaumont with its traditional thatched roof and stunning facade, but what's most important is what you'll find inside.

1. FORGET-BRIMONT, BRUT PREMIER CRU

NV, Champagne, France

Pale golden colour. Delicate nose, very fresh, lovely complexity. Fresh and supple on the palate. The first impression is of fresh green apples with a hint of white flowers and hazelnuts. Well balanced and good length.



2. FORGET-BRIMONT ROSE

NV, Champagne, France

A vibrant, elegant rosé Champagne offering aromas of wild strawberries, raspberries, and redcurrants, balanced by delicate notes of brioche, citrus peel, and rose petals. On the palate, it's crisp and refined, with fine bubbles and a creamy texture.



3. LAURENT PERRIER BRUT

Established in 1812 and now known as one of the largest family-owned champagne houses. Laurent-Perrier Brut has often been described as well defined and rounded with expressive flavours. Over time the fruit progressively emerges to a fine balanced champagne demonstrating a great length on the finish.



4. LAURENT PERRIER ROSÉ

Established in 1812 and now known as one of the largest family-owned champagne houses. Using only Pinot Noir from grand cru villages and the more unusual soak-on-the-skins method, it has delicious raspberry and redcurrant flavours.



5. DOM PÉRIGNON

2008, Champagne, France

Dom Pérignon is named after a 17th century Benedictine monk, Dom Pierre Pérignon (1638-1715), who is said to have invented sparkling wine during his tenure as cellarmaster at the Abbey of Hautvillers, near the town of Épernay. The palate reveals toasty, smoky complexity pairing with a powerful, dense core of ripe lemon fruit. The fine, yet creamy mousse adds more weight. Superb and precise.

28. MEURSAULT VILLAGES, DOMAINE MICHELOT

Bush Vine Pinotage is not from irrigated, over-cropped vines shackled to wires in horrifically hot and stressed out vineyards. Plummy aromas with a faint hit of barbecued meat. The palate is full and rich with slightly rustic yet moreish tannins and an impressively long finish.



38. VEGA DEL RAYO RIOJA SELECCIONADA

Rioja, Spain

Rioja Alta, around the town of Haro with Vines on average 15-20 years old. The nose has warm spice, ripe plum and cherry aromas while the palate is richly flavoured and substantial with black fruit and a smoky, spicy character from time in oak. Well-balanced, fruity and approachable.




39. "CIRCLE OF LIFE" RED, WATERKLOOF

Stellenbosch, South Africa

In 1993 Paul Boutinot commenced his search for a vineyard site with the potential to produce truly fine wine with a defining sense of origin, to create a new classic. A harmoniuosly integrated blend with great length that combines the spiciness of the Syrah, the fresh fruits of the Petit Verdot and the juiciness from the Merlot. The beginning is fresh and fruity with good acidity, evolving into riper flavours.

40. BAGLIO GIBELLINA PASSIMIENTO

Sicily, Italy

From the old vineyards shaken by intense pulsions that rise from the deep roots of the earth to shake the best grapes, this wine comes to life with an authentic Mediterranean fragrance. Bright intense red, characteristic, intense with hint of red berries fruits. Warm, full- bodied and harmonious in acidity, with smooth and elegant tannins.



41. FLEURIE, PIGEONNIER DU CHAPITRE

Beaujolais, France

Situated on the Fleurie hills between the villages of La Madone and Pionce, this Fleurie benefits from southern exposure which ensures maximum sunshine is obtained. Violet in colour, light and one of the most luscious fruity red wines. An elegant wine with smooth tannins, resulting in a plush mouthfeel and deep concentrated fruit flavours. The nose displays aromas of Iris, roses and peach, the palate is fruity and silky.



42. BLACK CRAFT SHIRAZ, MAGPIE ESTATE

Barossa Valley, Autralia

To 'knock knock' on wood is a well known method of keeping away bad luck, to ward off unlucky consequences, protection against evil, or attracting good luck. Blockbuster Barossa Shiraz with great depth and character. Typical deep colour, dense sweet black berry fruits on the nose, has a lovely savoury almost meaty character with hints of black pepper, meat and oak.



43. VINA REAL RIOJA GRAN RESERVA

Rioja, Spain

Tempranillo and Graciano combine to produce a refined elegant Gran Reserva with bright, crunchy fruit and a sprinkle of spice. Deep ruby red. Very intense and complex nose with notes developed during its ageing in barrels (coffee, and sweet spice), as well as aromas of candied fruits and nuts. The palate is very structured, full bodied.



44. BLOCK S38 CABERNET SAUVIGNON VINA CASA SILVA

Colchagna, Chile

S38 marks a single, small soil block in Casa Silva's iconic Los Lingues vineyard. A world-class Cabernet Sauvignon with limited production. An intense and deep ruby colour with aromatic notes of red fruits and spices. The wine has a powerful entry, silky tannins, balanced acidity, pleasant mouthfeel and an elegant and persistent finish.

45. CHÂTEAU TOUR DE MARBUZET

St Estèphe, Bordeaux, France

Château Tour de Marbuzet was originally part of the great Château MacCarthy estate, divided up and sold in 1854, and again in 1981 when it was bought by current owner, Henri Duboscq. Beautiful aromas of forest floor and blackberry cream along with spicy and dark chocolate notes. The palate is sumptuous, dense, and fleshy with creamy, rich tannins that do not lack freshness or dynamism.



Cabernets Sauvignons are indeed racy.

46. CHATEAUNEUF DOM CHANTE CIGALE

The wine has lots of warm red fruit and damson aromas with cinnamon, spices and jam but also concentration on the palate, then liquorice richness and elegance to finish.



47. CARMENERE "MICROTERROIR", CASA SILVA

Colchagua Valley, Chile

Viña Casa Silva began in 1997 in pursuit of a long-held dream of sharing the family's love and affection for its land in the Colchagua Valley in a bottle of wine. Picked from extremely small "micro" plots of 0.1 to 0.4 hectares of carefully selected parcels, it delivers true Carmenere fruit personality. A distinctive smoky, spicy character with lovely ripeness, depth and length.



48. CHOREY-LES-BEAUNE, MAISON ALBERT BICHOT

Côte de Beaune, Burgundy, France

Located in the heart of Côte de Beaune, this commune is known for elegant reds. Aromas of ripe cherry and raspberry with hints of toast, spice, and leather. Soft and round on the palate with a refined tannic structure and fragrant finish.







49. AMARONE DELLA VALPOLICELLA SATINATO MONTRESOR

Vento, Italy

Giacomo Montresor patented the "frosted" bottle to protect the wine from the sunlight of the ocean during the first ship transports to North America. Since then, Amarone Satinato Montresor is unique, original and iconic. Its timeless elegance is the same as those who recognize it, choose it and taste it. Deep garnet red. On the nose scents of ripe red fruit with delicate spicy notes. Good structure, warm and velvety on the palate with sour cherry and spices aftertaste.

50. CROZES-HERMITAGE FREDERICK REVERDY

Rhone, France

This Crozes-Hermitage showcases the elegance and purity of Syrah from the northern Rhône. Aromas of blackberry, plum, and blackcurrant lead the way, with subtle hints of violet, black pepper, and smoked meat in the background.



51. BRUNELLO DI MONTALCINO LA MANELLA

Tuscany, Italy

The Cortonesi winery is a family-owned winery, owned by the family of the same name, native of Montalcino. It offers slightly contained aromas at first that open to reveal dark berry fruit, rose petal and crushed stone. This wine remains direct and accessible with a medium-weight approach backed by fine and structured tannins.



52. BRIO DE CANTENAC BROWN, MARGAUX

Rhône Valley, France

Château Cantenac Brown is a 1855 classified third growth, located in Cantenac within the most prestigious Médoc appellation, Margaux. Bio de Cantenac is the second wine of the estate. Charming, delicate and brilliant, a pleasurable wine for sharing. 50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 43% Merlot & 7% Cabernet Franc. Rich and deep colour, with purple and red garnet shades. The nose reveals a blend of ripe fruits aromas with hints of vanilla.



53. CHÂTEAU CARONNE STE GEMME 1983

Haut Médoc, Bordeaux

The 1983 Château Caronne Ste. Gemme from Haut-Médoc is a classic Bordeaux blend, primarily composed of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and a touch of Petit Verdot. This vintage is known for its balance and finesse, making it a delightful experience for those who appreciate mature Bordeaux wines. On the palate, it offers a lovely tannic structure that is well-balanced with the wine's acidity and alcohol. You might also notice earthy notes such as leather and smoke.

54. CHATEAU HAUT MARBUZET, SAINT ESTEPHE

Saint-Estephe, France

In 1952, Hervé Duboscq, whose family was from Gascony, had the foresight to take on 7 hectares of land in St. Estèphe in the north of the Médoc from the McCarthy family, one of the famous 'Wild Geese' families from Ireland who had settled in Bordeaux in the 17th century. From the outset the Duboscqs developed their own style, favouring greater approachability when compared with the more muscular wines of other St. Estèphe estates. The estate's top wine. Carries earthy notes with a rather long nose. The tannins are very strong and present, and the wine is overall opulent and superb.




55. ANTINORI TIGNANELLO

Antinori is the most famous name in Italian wine and the influence of Piero Antinori in the last 25 years has been nothing short of revolutionary. The 2014 Tignanello is loaded with finesse, delivering juicy Marasca cherry, cassis, star anise and white pepper with remarkable precision. It's fresh and balanced by vibrant acidity and elegant, firm and silky tannins.







56. THE MAGNIFICENT MALBEC, DON CRISTOBAL

Lujan de Cuyo, Mendoza, Argentina

Don Cristobal is a family owned winery that started its activities in 1998 with the solid commitment to produce quality wines with personality. 


60. EDELSPATZ NOBLE (37.5cl Bottle) LATE HARVEST RIESLING, DELHEIM D.O
